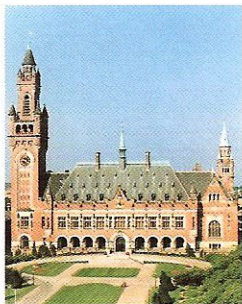

In 1899, Czar Nicholas II called an international peace conference in The Hague, The Netherlands, the first step in a process designed to find peace through negotiation rather than by military confrontation. Though this unique experiment had limited success, it is historically important as the first attempt at permanent international arbitration. The documentary 'One Century for Peace' visualizes this ideal showing the ages-old struggle between the war-like "hawks" and the peaceful "doves" of the world.
